received Purple Heart

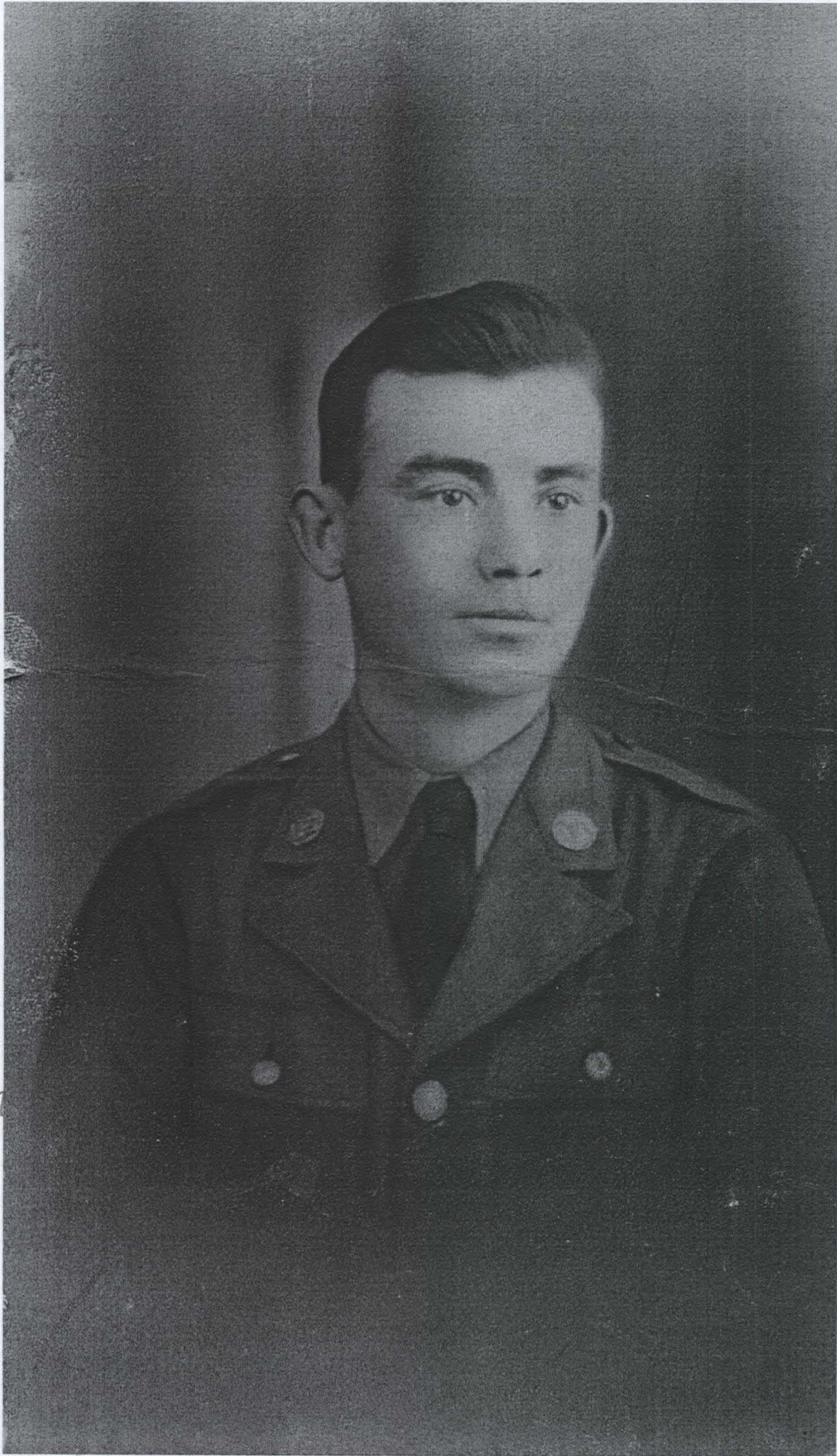
